The Augustowski Canal

The Augustów Canal was built in the years 1824-1839. It is 103.4 km long and has 18 locks, 15 in Poland and 3 in Belarus. It overcomes a water level difference of more than 54 meters. The main builder of the canal was the Polish engineer General Ignacy Prądzyński. Today it is a fantastic gateway to a water adventure and a charming historical monument. "Kanał Augustowski" was recognized as a Historical Monument by the ordinance of the President of Poland of April 25, 2007.

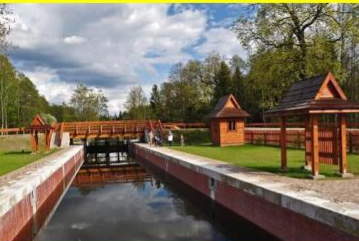

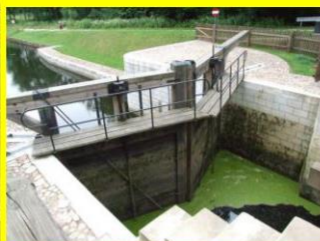

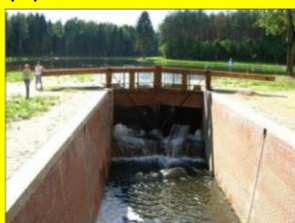
